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ADVISORY SERVICES

Libraries are in a unique position to offer patrons customized recommendations on what to read, watch, listen to and view as they discover the richness of our vast collection. Not only do people look to us for this type of help, but it is one of our offerings that sets us apart from our competitors and helps libraries remain relevant in the lives of those we serve. To increase awareness about our advisory services, Arapahoe Libraries will offer an expanded program of vetted and personalized recommendations on books, movies, music, e-resources and more. The result will be an increase in the quality and quantity of advisory interactions between patrons and staff.

CHAMPION FOR LIFELONG LEARNING

To live up to the promises made to our constituents in the 2015 election, Arapahoe Libraries will serve as a champion for lifelong learning. We will provide updated books, technology and research materials so that our community is enriched by these resources. We will provide literacy-based programs and work with parents and caregivers to ensure our youngest patrons have a strong foundation in literacy and are school-ready. We will increase services for our aging population and provide a link to the outside world for our patrons who cannot visit the library in person. We will provide lifelong educational opportunities, support and training to help our patrons and the community grow in literacy skills, including cultural literacy and technological literacy.
