What can I expect from a meeting with a Community Resource Specialist?

Community resource specialists are available to meet with you one-on-one at your preferred Arapahoe Libraries location, via telephone, or email, to determine what agencies or resources are able to meet your needs.

What else should I know?

Conversations with community resource specialists are confidential, with a few exceptions:

- When consulting with their supervisors and team members as a means to ensure excellent service to our patrons.
- If a patron mentions harm to themselves, a child, or older adult to ensure safety for all.
- If served with a lawful court order or subpoena.

Community resource specialists can refer you to social service agencies; however, they do not provide counseling, therapy, or case management.
