Emergency Adult Shelter

Comitis Crisis Center—Aurora

A monthly emergency shelter for adults, ages 18+

Lottery line: 303-317-8990. Call 5 a.m.–12 p.m. on the last day of the month, and call again to confirm after 2 p.m. Monthly stays begins on the first day of the month.

Single men, women, and couples without children, ages 18+
No pets or emotional support animals and must be able to get up and down off the floor without help
Must consent to background check

- If open, call the hotline back, visit a service provider (Littleton Life Center, Movement 5280, and Giving Heart), or go to <https://swshelternetwork.com/shelter-status/> beginning at 9 a.m. to reserve your spot for shelter. Reservations are accepted until 4 p.m. or until full.
- Englewood guests will be within walking distance of the shelter.
- Bus tickets are handed out at Littleton Life Center from 3–4 p.m. to help Littleton guests to get to shelter.
