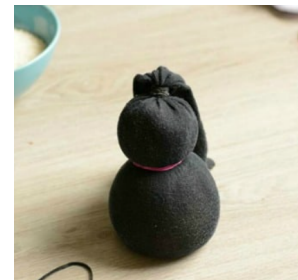
Supplies

- Grab & Go Craft Kit: 1 brown fluffy sock, 1 plain sock, 3-4 rubber bands, 1 tacky glue stick, 3 squares of felt, 2 googly eyes, 1 cup of rice

From Home: Scissors

Instructions

1. Fill the plain sock with all the rice - It's easiest to stretch the sock over the cup and then dump.
2. Tie the sock with a rubber band. Use another rubber band to make the head shape.
3. Place the rice-filled plain sock in the brown fluffy sock. The excess sock may be cut off, or it can be folded under so that cutting is not necessary.
4. Cut tail feathers out of the felt squares, 6 total. You can draw the shape or just freehand it.
5. Use the tacky glue stick to glue the tail feathers together in a fan shape. Then glue the tail to the back & bottom of the sock. It may take a few minutes of applying pressure to make it stick.
6. Cut out a small triangle beak from one of the felt squares and adhere it to face with glue.
7. Add two googly eyes.
8. Enjoy your new festive fall sock buddy!
