

GRAB AND GO KITS

Snowperson Lantern

SUPPLIES

GRAB & GO KIT: 1 jar, 1 foam ball, 1 ribbon, 1 glitter glue stick, 1 paintbrush,
1 carrot nose, 2 tiny brads (for eyes), 2 branch arms, 3 buttons, 1 sheet of glue dots, 1 tealight candle
FROM HOME: Black marker or pen (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Gather the supplies from your kit and home
2. Place foam ball at the opening of the jar, it should sit snugly on top and serve as the snowperson's head
3. Add face features, such as carrot nose and brad eyes, by pushing them into the foam
4. OPTIONAL: If desired, use a marker or pen to draw a mouth
5. Use glue dots to adhere the top hat to the top of the foam ball
6. Add branch arms to the sides of the foam ball



7. Tie the ribbon around the neck of the jar to create a scarf (or secure with glue dots)
8. Use glue dots to adhere buttons to the front of the jar
9. Remove snowman head from the jar and place to the side. Carefully squeeze glitter glue into the jar. Use the paintbrush to spread a thin layer of glitter all around the inside of the jar. Let the glue dry overnight.
10. Once glitter glue is completely dry, place the battery operated tealight candle into the jar, replace the snowperson's head on top and proudly display your DIY winter decoration!
