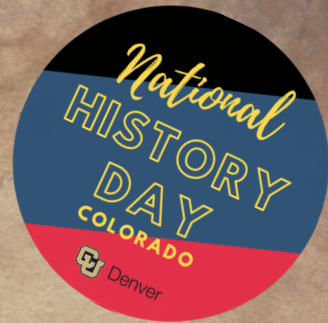

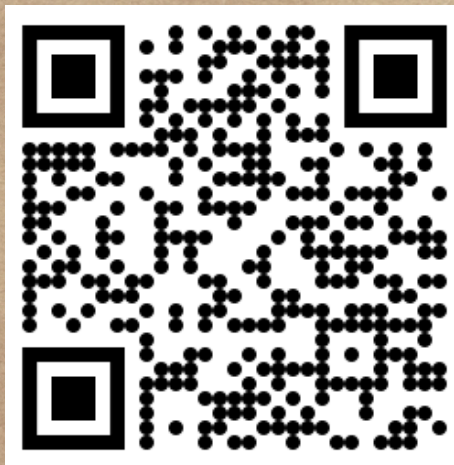

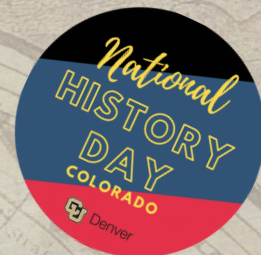

JUDGING NHD



What is NHD?

National History Day (NHD) is a pre-collegiate history & civics program for students in grades 6–12. Each student selects a historical topic, creates a project, and competes with it, developing communication, critical thinking, & project management skills.

How judges make a difference:

The judges' evaluation helps students improve their skills and provides positive feedback and constructive criticism for the hard work students have put into producing their projects.

How you can help:

Historians, teachers, librarians & community members! Judging begins the week prior & day of the contest. You will evaluate & interview students about their projects, while working collaboratively with a judging partner to rank projects at the regional and/or state levels.
